Without gigantic mountains, this flatter place, a spectacular plateau with tropical profusion and vibrant lives provides incredible sceneries and infinite inspiration.”

Born in China, **Jing Zhou** is an interdisciplinary artist, designer, researcher, and educator in the U.S. She works at the intersection of visual communication design, interactive media, data visualization, and animation/video.
